

## Perspectives on pollination from the Old World

This talk will summarize some of the recently discovered plant-pollinator interactions in Africa. These findings will be contextualized in the framework of broader questions about plant reproductive ecology and the role of pollination niches for diversification of angiosperms. The value of comparing Old and New World pollination systems will be highlighted.
